Details of the expedition:

Timings: Students to attend academy for Morning meeting as usual.

Itinerary:

- 08.45** Depart academy for university campus
- 09.15** Arrive at campus and register in
- 09.30 – 12.15** STEM Workshops
- 12.15-12.45** Lunch at the university
- 12.45-14.30** STEM Workshops
- 14.30** Depart university
- 15.00 approx.** Return to Dixons Trinity

As always, a full risk assessment is available to ensure students are safe throughout the expedition.

Uniform: Academy PE uniform. Consider appropriate footwear, outer layers, hats and gloves etc. The students will walk to the university and back.

Equipment: Please ensure all pupils arrive with their full equipment including **scientific calculator**.

Lunch arrangements: A packed lunch will be provided by the school.

Mobile phones: Are not allowed. All staff members will have a mobile phone in case of an emergency and for communicating with the school/holding digital trip tickets.
